What is included in your membership?

Our plans include regular dental health appointments and hygiene appointments within the monthly cost, helping you maintain healthy teeth and gums. The number of dental health examinations and/or hygiene visits you receive as part of your plan will be recommended by your dentist and dependant on your current oral health, meaning the plan is tailored specifically to you and your dental health needs.

How do these appointments help you?

Dental health examinations provide:

- Clinical examination to catch developing problems early
- Checking for signs of oral cancer for early detection
- X-rays where clinically necessary for an in-depth examination of your oral health.

Hygiene appointments provide:

- Professional removal of harmful hard plaque
- Advice and techniques – we work with you to prevent tooth decay and gum disease
- Fresher breath and a brighter smile for improved self-esteem.

Why do our memberships include total health screenings?

You can look great, feel great, and exercise regularly. That doesn't always tell the whole story. When it comes to your health, there are five numbers you need to know: blood pressure, glucose, cholesterol, waist to height ratio and BMI. Any one of these numbers can indicate an increased risk for conditions such as heart disease and diabetes.

We know that dental health and whole-body health have a significant overlap and one affects the other much more than was previously realised. Research already shows links between gum disease and many conditions such as diabetes, heart disease and blood pressure. Links between gum disease and some forms of dementia have also been found recently too.

We know lots of people do not see their doctor regularly or are unaware of their key numbers, so we offer a simple 5 point health screening so that you can get to 'know your numbers'.

A health screening appointment involves:

- ✓ A blood pressure check
- ✓ A cholesterol screen
- ✓ A glucose screen
- ✓ Waist to height ratio assessment
- ✓ BMI assessment

Your results will be immediate and, depending on the findings, we will either offer advice or refer you to your doctor. A follow up test in 6 months may be advised.
